TREASURES OF GOLD

The story is told of a man who became the chief beneficiary of his grandmother's estate. At the reading of her will, he discovered that she had bequeathed to him the family Bible and the remainder of her worldly possessions after her debts had been paid. After bills and taxes, he was left with just a few hundred dollars. This man lived a hard life, scraping to make ends meet as he strove to raise his family through some difficult times. Thirty-five years passed before he opened the family Bible and began thumbing through its pages. To his surprise, he discovered five thousand dollars neatly tucked away in its pages. After the initial joy subsided, the man began to feel ashamed that it had taken him so long to open the Bible. He thought of all the times this money might have been used while he was raising his children. Tears came to his eyes as he thought of the needless suffering his family endured because he had not taken the time to open the family Bible.

When was the last time you opened your family Bible? How much suffering has your family endured because you did not seek the treasures found in God's word? David rightly appraises the value of God's word, saying, "How sweet are Your words to my taste! Yes, sweeter than honey to my mouth!" (Psa. 119:103). And, again, "Therefore I love Your commandments above gold, yes, above fine gold" (Psa. 119:127). With such sweetness and richness contained in God's word, it is incumbent on each of us to make careful search, seeking precious nourishment for our souls.
